

After a difficult leg, Jan Černý goes for points at Rally Poland

Two punctures and an error at a junction have not allowed the Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver to stand out. However, from the first stages they managed to advance to fifth position, a place that they will defend on the last day of this event of the World Rally Championship, which will celebrate the third and final leg tomorrow, Sunday.

It was not the desired day for Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča. The second leg of the Rally Poland, a day highlighted in red to try to gain a foothold in the general classification, has not gone as those in the Ford Rally3 expected. Despite everything, they are still in the race to try to win some points that could be very important at the end of the season.

In the early stages, those from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport managed to reach fifth position, a goal that they had within reach and that rewarded the effort made after the incident on Friday morning.

But it wasn't the day. Two punctures and an error at a junction translated into a significant loss of time that, however, did not jeopardize the fifth position that, as the kilometers passed, they had managed to stabilize.

In this way, those of the Ford Rally3 will face the last leg on Sunday, with just over 60 kilometers of route, with the fifth position, a result that they will try to materialize to score points again in a rally of the world championship.

"It has not been the day we expected. Today we wanted to push, but a double puncture and a mistake at a junction made us lose time", the Tenerife-based driver declared at the end of the leg. "The punctures were bad luck, maybe some stones on the road, while I accept the mistake at the braking point at the intersection", he commented, feeling sad about the sensations of the day. "Tomorrow there is one last leg in which the objective is none other than to add the points we now have. There are four stages, of significant length, in which we will have to maintain concentration", assessed the Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver at the end of the day.
