## Jan Černý scores important points in the Rally Poland and holds the third place in WRC3

The Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver finally finished in fifth position in WRC3. In this way, he manages to score some important points in the World Championship, which allows him to maintain the third position in WRC3 with which he arrived on Polish event.

Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča achieved fifth position in WRC3 this Sunday at the conclusion of the Rally Poland, an event that represented their fourth round in the World Rally Championship (WRC) after Monte – Carlo, Sweden and Portugal.

Those in the Ford Rally3 could do little in a leg that only included four special stages and just over 60 timed kilometers. The distances with respect to the first four classified were insurmountable under normal conditions, so the couple from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport took their vehicle to the final finish line in an important fifth position in WRC3 that awards points that can be very valid at the end of the 2024 season.

Precisely, with this points, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča maintain third position in WRC3, one of the most exciting categories of the WRC. It was undoubtedly not the result that the Tenerifebased driver wanted, especially after having carried out excellent prior preparation with a rally held last Sunday and the tests on Monday, but the problems found in the first and second legs hampered his options.

"It was not the rally we wanted, but sometimes this feeling is part of the game", said the Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver. "The problems in the first two legs conditioned our participation in the Rally Poland, but we managed to overcome them to climb to fifth position and thus remain on the podium in the WRC3 - World Rally Championship", stressed the driver of the Ford Rally3. "We take away important experience for our next participations", he highlighted.
