





PR 19/24 | FIA World Rally Championship – WRC3 Central European Rally

Jan Černý will fight for the podium in WRC3 at the next Central European Rally

The second edition of this rally in the World Rally Championship will be held from October 17 to 20. Like last year, it has a peculiarity, and that is that it travels to three countries during the weekend: Germany, Austria and the Czech Republic. Already in the final stretch of the contest, the driver based on the island of Tenerife maintains all his options for a podium in the WRC3 category.

After a few weeks, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča will return to the World Rally Championship (WRC). The driver supported by Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport has taken advantage of these months to continue competing in different countries in Europe and, in this way, remain in good shape just before fighting for a podium in the World Rally Championship.

The Ford Rally3 driver will compete, from October 17 to 20, in the second edition of the Central European Rally. This very particular event that was held for the first time last year has a particularity that makes it unique. During the course of the weekend its stages take place in three different countries: Germany, Austria and the Czech Republic.

After having competed on the frozen tarmac of Monte-Carlo, the snow of Sweden and the gravel of Portugal and Poland, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča have to do the rest on the pure asphalt of this next event.

"I am very excited about my return to the World Championship. The options for the podium in WRC3 are intact and involve doing a good role in the Central European Rally", acknowledges the driver based in Adeje (Tenerife). "We would like to repeat the Monte-Carlo triumph, it would be a nice culmination of this fantastic project at an international level," he underlines. On the other hand, he added that "it is super exciting to compete in the Czech Republic as part of the WRC, I never thought that something like this could happen to me", specifies the one who will undoubtedly be one of the stars of that weekend.
