

Jan Černý begins his fight for a podium in the WRC3 category

The Adeje based driver took part in the Rally Herbst (Austria) this weekend, where he was fifth overall and first in his category. With everything ready, starting this Thursday, it will compete in an event that will travel through the countries of the Czech Republic, Germany and Austria, the Central Europe Rally. Their objective is to fight for victory in their category to secure a podium place in the WRC3 category.

Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča return to the World Rally Championship (WRC) on the occasion of the Central Europe Rally, an event that celebrates its second edition in the c'ship and which, as a great incentive, runs through the countries of the Czech Republic, Germany and Austria.

Those of the Ford Rally3 are going to arrive at a good pace for their fifth round in the 2024 WRC. This past weekend they competed in the Rally Herbst held in Austria, where they took note of terrain similar to the one they will encounter this weekend and, at the same time, they were fifth and first in their category.

Currently, the Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver is only two points away from third place and fourteen from second place. In this way, achieving a good result in the Central Europe Rally could give him an absolute podium in the WRC3 category of the World Championship.

“Competing at the world level in my country, the Czech Republic, is an honor. I hope this will help us achieve a good result”, hopes Jan Černý. “We have options for the podium in WRC3 and we want to take advantage of it, it would be the best present for all the sponsors who have supported us throughout 2024”, emphasizes the Adeje based driver. “Due to the type of terrain, it will surely be one of the most difficult rallies of the season. For our part, we are already looking forward to starting”. says the one from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport.

The action will begin this Thursday with the shakedown (Točná, 2.11 km) and with the 'Chuchle' (2.55 km at 3:05 p.m.) and 'Klatovy' (11.78 km at 6:26 p.m.) stages. h). On Friday the routes will be 'Klatovy' (11.78 km at 8:02 a.m. and 1:11 p.m.), 'Strasin' (26.69 km at 9:32 a.m. and 4:14 p.m.) and 'Sumavské Hostice' (16.85 km at 10:42 a.m. and 5:24 p.m.). The longest day will be on Saturday, with 'Granit und Wald' (20.05 km at 7:58 a.m. and 2:28 p.m.), 'Beyond Borders' (24.33 km at 9:05 a.m. and 3:35 p.m. h) and 'Schärdinger Innviertel' (17.35 km at 10:34 a.m. and 5:04 p.m.). This edition of the Central Europe Rally will conclude on Sunday after passing

through 'Kanus Tabbert Am Hochwald' (12.17 km at 9:11 a.m. and 11:33 a.m.) and 'Passauer Land' (14.87 km at 10:35 a.m. h and 1:15 p.m.).
