## Strong result for Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča in the 93 Rally Monte - Carlo

For the second consecutive year, those from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport took advantage of the passage through the Col de Turini to certify a brilliant result in the opening round of the 2025 World Rally Championship. Those from the Citroën C3 Rally2 were second in WRC2 Challenger and fourth in WRC2. The next goal is to be at the start of the 49 Rally Islas Canarias.

The 93 Rally Monte – Carlo concluded honoring its history, that is, with delicate stages and with the snow coloring the last special with drama, that of the Col de Turini, a setting in which Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča once again performed at a very high level. With the only pass through that road they certified the second place in WRC2 Challenger and fourth in WRC2.

Those from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport faced a short day, in fact, there were only three stages and just over 50 timed kilometers. But here, the Rally Monte – Carlo reserved its moment to add some spice to the final outcome. The early morning rain and the corresponding ice everywhere, the final day's specials had very delicate conditions.

Therefore, the tire choice was of incalculable value. In this situation, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča knew how to suffer in very precarious grip conditions, reaching the last special stage with very short differences, although always in their favor. Inspired by the performance of 2023, and pushing hard in the delicate descent to Peira Cava, they claimed the podium place in WRC2 Challenger and the good points of fourth place in WRC2.

"I'm very happy, it's an exceptional result to start the season", commented the Citroën C3 Rally2 rider from Monaco, the arrival point of this Rally Monte - Carlo. "It has been a very difficult rally, the first two stages of this Sunday were very complicated; there we were able to defend ourselves without risking, we didn't want to make any mistake", he said. "On the Col de Turini, like last year, we were comfortable again, even though this time the conditions were very different. In the end, everything went well, we were able to defend both positions and we took home a great experience with the Citroën C3 Rally2 and some good points", stressed the Tenerife-based driver. Now, his goal is clear: "we are going to work to be at the start of the Rally Islas Canarias".

Without a program yet defined in the WRC2 category of the World Rally Championship (WRC), Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča are already working to find the necessary budget to allow them to be at the start of the 49 Rally Islas Canarias (April 24/27). Without a doubt, the result achieved



































in this demanding 93 Rally Monte – Carlo predicts a good season for the driver of Czech origin, who is optimistic about the possibility of carrying out more events at this level.
