

## Jan Černý leads the WRC3 category after the first stages of the Rally Monte - Carlo

The Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver is dominating the WRC3 category after having won seven of the eight stages so far. This Saturday will run a leg that has six special stages and 120.4 kilometers, that is, the longest of the four that have been scheduled for this edition.

The 92nd edition of the Rally Monte – Carlo began on Thursday night and continued this Friday to compete in a total of eight special stages. The Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport team, formed by Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča, are at the top of the WRC3 category after a sensational start.

The Canarian driver of Czech origin took the first special, held on Thursday night, as an adaptation. Not only with the Ford WRC3, but the conditions of some stages that, as is tradition, have been very delicate due to the ice and mud that the teams have encountered along the way. After that contact, and with good information from the *ouvriers*, in the second special stage Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča took control of their category.

Improving considerably after the first stage on Friday, and with a correct tire choice, Jan and Ondřej became stronger in WRC3, a category that they lead with just over five minutes ahead. Along the way, they have won seven of the eight stages celebrated in their category.

“We are leading the WRC3 category and that is something incredible for us”, highlighted Jan Černý while addressing the service in Gap. “We are very concentrated to get the points in this category”, said the driver of Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur. “The first special stage on Friday was difficult, with many teams out of the road; we were very cautious, but then we started to improve, we made the right tire choice, and in the end we won many stages. In the last one of the day, again at night, the conditions were also difficult and we were very cautious”, explained the leader of the WRC3 category.

The 92 Monte – Carlo Rally continues this Saturday with another six stages, a day that has a decisive 120.4 kilometers to achieve the objectives proposed by the team supported by Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport. In fact, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča will face

the longest day of the current edition of this event that opens the 2024 World Rally Championship.
