





PR 4/24 | FIA World Rally Championship – WRC3 92 Rally Monte - Carlo

Jan Černý begins the year with victory in the Rally Monte – Carlo and starts leading the World Championship in WRC3

After an exciting last day, the Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver achieved victory in WRC3 and RC3. His scratch at the 'Col de Turini' was decisive in obtaining this double victory. Thus, the Canarian driver of Czech origin begins leading the World Rally Championship in its WRC3 division.

Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča have done it. Those from Costa Adeje Tenerife Sur and Ángel Bello Motorsport have achieved an important victory in the 92 Monte – Carlo Rally, the first round of the World Rally Championship. Those of the Ford Rally3 added the victory in WRC3 and in RC3 after a spectacular performance in the legendary 'Col de Turini', a special stage that has concluded this first rally of the year.

The Canarian driver of Czech origin started this short and final leg very well. The best time in 'La Bréole / Selonnet' placed him in the lead among the RC3 class, but in 'Digne-les-Bains / Chaudo-Norante' the famous *black ice* so famous in this edition of the 'Monte – Carlo' made them with some caution, so they returned to second place among the RC3; along the way they already had a lead of more than ten minutes in WRC3.

But there was still one last chance, the one corresponding to the 'La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini' special, the most famous stage in the world. With victory in WRC3 practically assured, Jan Černý and Ondřej Krajča went flat out and achieved their goal: to win in WRC3 and RC3, in the first case with a lead of 10:42.6 and in the second by just 1, 9 seconds.

"In the last stage we went completely flat out, we pushed like a hell," said Jan Černý towards the final podium located in Monaco. "In the previous stage we encountered many patches of ice and we didn't want to make a stupid mistake with our strong leadership in WRC3," stressed the Costa Adeje Tenerife South and Ángel Bello Motorsport driver. "On the Col de Turini the conditions reminded me a lot of the stages in the Canary Islands and that helped me achieve victory," explained Černý. "We have found many fans from the islands supporting us and many flags, it has been incredible," stated the first leader in WRC3 of the season.
